The Undergraduate Intensive English Language Study Program will enroll 120 undergraduate students around the world who demonstrate the potential to become leaders, in eight-week intensive English Language courses at colleges and universities in the United States, starting in June 2011.

The Undergraduate Intensive English Language Study Program will provide participants with intensive English language training, a focus on English language acquisition, leadership skill building, and civic education and engagement. The primary focus of the program is intensive English language coursework, but programs also include components on leadership training and participating in community service and volunteerism that is focused on issues such as public health and wellness or environmental conservation and sustainability. Participants will develop a plan to implement an outreach project upon their return home that is based on specific needs of their communities. Throughout the program participants will attend a number of cultural events and excursions and have opportunities to interact with American citizens.
